

## **OKLAHOMA CITY ASSOCIATION OF LEASE AND TITLE ANALYSTS SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION GUIDELINES**

### **Requirements**

**To be considered, applicants must meet the following requirements:**

- Minimum of sixty (60) credit hours in a fully accredited college or university
- Grade point average of 2.5 or greater
- Complete an OCAPLTA Scholarship Application form in full
- Attach a recent photo of applicant with application
- Attach a certified copy of latest college or university transcript(s) with application
- Mail application and attachments to the OCAPLTA Scholarship Fund at the address shown at the top of the application form
- All applications and required information must be received by OCAPLTA by May 31<sup>st</sup>

### **Scholarship Priorities**

An OCAPLTA member who is currently employed in the energy industry and attending school full or part-time to complete an energy industry or business related degree will be given first priority.

A child or relative of a current member of OCAPLTA who is an Energy Management (EM) major and/or a Petroleum Land Management (PLM) major currently enrolled full-time in a fully accredited EM/PLM program at a college or university.

An EM/PLM major who is not a child or relative of a current member of OCAPLTA, but is currently enrolled full-time in a fully accredited EM/PLM program at a college or university.

### **Miscellaneous**

The OCAPLTA Board shall not be obligated to award any scholarship during any fiscal year.

Notwithstanding the priorities set forth above, any person awarded the OCAPLTA Scholarship shall not be eligible for application in the year immediately succeeding such an award.

The OCAPLTA Scholarship Committee will review and validate all applicants. Once applicants have been validated, the Scholarship Committee will determine by a vote the top three applicants. If three or less applicants apply and qualify, a vote of one applicant will be determined. The applicant name(s) will be submitted to the OCAPLTA Board of Directors for a final vote at the July board meeting.

Scholarships granted by OCAPLTA will be paid directly to the educational institution. Scholarship payments shall be awarded once the Scholarship Committee receives satisfactory proof that the recipient is enrolled in a fully accredited college or university.

All OCAPLTA scholarship guidelines must be approved by the OCAPLTA Board of Directors and are subject to change at any time.
